Project Title: The Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) and Quanzhou Normal University (QNU) Collaboration Project

The appointees will participate in a project to develop an online computer adaptive testing system to assess pre-service teachers' digital assessment literacy, as well as statistical analysis of the assessment data. The project will last for 36 months.

The appointees will learn and be involved in a wide range of research knowledge and skills: (a) Rasch model and other IRT models using R, (b) Advanced quantitative data analyses using Mplus, (c) Development of a Computer Adaptive Testing platform, (d) Research on Automatic Item Generation, (e) Using AI for research in social science, and (f) Building a website from the installation of the Linux system to application deployment.

Applicants for Senior Research Assistant should have a Master's degree in in Statistics, Data Science, Engineering, Psychology, or a related discipline plus one year post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral degree in the above mentioned disciplines.

Applicants for Research Assistant I should have a Bachelor's degree in Statistics, Data Science, Engineering, Psychology, or a related discipline.

They must possess strong teamwork skills. Preference will be given to those who are experienced in R programming, including Shiny, more than one skill listed above (a - f) and willing to learn. Passion for educational research and sustainable development is desirable. The applicant should be local or holding a valid VISA such as an IANG or Student VISA with no objection letter.
