

## Teaching Assistant (Ref: 2400318) Department of Literature and Cultural Studies

The Department of Literature and Cultural Studies at The Education University of Hong Kong is seeking inspirational and energetic candidates for the positions of Teaching Assistant to support its growing scope of learning and teaching initiatives. This is an exciting opportunity for those who wish to be part of a committed and enthusiastic team eager to develop a career in higher education.

The successful applicants will join a team of highly qualified educators to deliver a variety of learning and teaching activities by 1 August 2024. Responsibilities mainly include (i) planning and organising in-class and extra-curricular activities for students; (ii) providing pastoral support to students; (iii) providing administrative support to courses/programmes; (iv) serving as Secretary in course/programme meetings; (v) assisting in courses/programmes where necessary; and (vi) occasional travel to mainland China to support activities where necessary.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree, in Chinese Literature, Chinese Language and Chinese Culture, or other related areas, with some experience in organizing student activities and providing teaching support. They should be proficient in both English and Chinese (especially Putonghua), proficiency in spoken Cantonese is preferred. They should also be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, be able to work independently and collectively as a good team member and have the ability to work under pressure. Those with experience in providing teaching support in tertiary institutions will have advantages. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
