He/she will learn and be involved in a wide range of research knowledge and skills: literature review, communication with university students and professors in Mainland China and experts in assessment to collect qualitative and quantitative data, and prepare research reports under supervision. He/she will also learn and use advanced research methods to analyze qualitative and quantitative data, and perform other duties as assigned. The appointment will be for a period of 24 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree or above in Psychology, Education or a related discipline. Applicants should have a good command of spoken and written Mandarin and English, and being familiar with Minnan Culture is desirable. Preference will be given to those with extensive psychological or educational research experience (e.g. final year research project, knowledge of statistical analysis using Mplus, R, or Winsteps, or qualitative analysis using NVivo). Passion for educational research and sustainable development is desirable.
