The appointee will collaborate with the principal investigator and research partners to provide support in various research and administrative tasks. Responsibilities may include conducting literature reviews, collecting and managing data, performing data entry and analysis, implementing and analyzing students' assessments, coordinating interviews and events, liaising with partnering schools and external stakeholders, and other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointee will have to work on-site, occasionally for irregular hours, and also closely with collaborating partners and schools.

Applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree in a related field and demonstrate a high level of proficiency in both spoken and written English and Cantonese. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills are essential, along with the ability to work independently and collaboratively within a team environment.
