The project will be one year in duration and includes initiatives related to history education. The appointee will assist in administrative work of the project, coordinate with the Education Bureau and secondary school teachers, support events and activities and perform other departmental duties as assigned.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with (a) a Bachelor's Degree in history, humanities, education or a related discipline, (b) several years of full-time and post-qualification working experience. High proficiency in both written and spoken English and Chinese is required. The appointee is expected to report to duty in May 2024.
