We are seeking enthusiastic and self-motivated individuals to join us in research and impact development. Typical responsibilities include supporting the management of research projects and research postgraduate programmes; conducting statistical/analytical work to improve development; implementing strategies to grow the faculty's research culture and efforts; serving committees; organising events, and carrying out general duties as required. The appointment will be for a period of 2 years.

The Executive Officer II will play a crucial role in enhancing and promoting the impact of research and external engagement with research activities. The main duties will involve managing grant applications, evidencing knowledge transfer and impact, and collaborating closely with departments to cultivate a flourishing impact culture.

Applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree with several years of post-qualification experience. They should have good communication and interpersonal skills, a flexible approach to work, a questioning and analytical mind, and excellent organisational and problem-solving abilities. The appointees should be highly proficient in English and Chinese, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work well with computers and maintain online systems/databases effectively. Experience in administering research projects and/or research postgraduate programmes will be an advantage.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
