The appointed individual will have the responsibility of supporting research projects. Additionally, administrative support to the research team is expected from the appointee. They will also be required to carry out other duties as assigned by the Project Supervisor. The initial appointment will be on a contract basis for 12 months, with the possibility of renewal depending on performance and mutual agreement.

Applicants should have (i) a Bachelor's degree or above, preferably in the areas of psychology, educational psychology, information technology, or computer science & engineering related discipline.; (ii) an excellent command of written and spoken English, and Chinese; (iii) a strong sense of responsibility; (iv) good communication skills; and (v) HK citizenship and abode in Hong Kong. Preference will be given to those with research experience.
