Project Title: Generative Artificial Intelligence Empowered Collaborative Learning: Models,

Algorithms, and System

[Appointment Period: 3-12 months]

The appointee will participate in a research project focused on Artificial Intelligence Generated Content (AIGC) for collaborative learning. He/she will be responsible for

- studying the requirements of leveraging generative artificial intelligence to empower collaborative learning;
- studying algorithms of artificial intelligence generated content and proposing new solutions, framework or methodologies student engagement promotion and knowledge mastery improvement;
- designing and implementing AI agent prototypes to support collaborative learning; and
- performing any other duties as assigned by Principal Investigator or his delegates.

There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publications in international journals or conferences. The initial appointment will be for a period of 3 to 12 months, depending on the applicant's qualifications.

Applications should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably a Bachelor's Degree or above in Data Science, Computer Science, Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, Educational Technology or a closely related discipline with expertise in data science or artificial intelligence. He/she should have hands-on experience in programming and background knowledge in Chinese, as well as good interpersonal and communication skills. The applicant should be mature and able to work independently. Preference will be given to those with research and/or project development experience.
