The Department is seeking a qualified and highly dedicated person to assist in teaching academic and professional development programmes for a project titled "English Learning Support Programme for Primary School Students with Dyslexia." This project aims to develop and implement a tiered intervention model: supporting the learning of English as a second language for primary school students with reading and writing difficulties.

The appointee will participate in activities related to teaching, curriculum, course and programme development (including face-to-face and online courses focusing on supporting students with English learning difficulties), liaison with internal and external stakeholders, engagement of SEN students and their parents, and other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator of the Project and the Department.

For the post of Lecturer I, applicants should have a Master's degree, in Education, preferably in English Language plus a minimum of four years' relevant post-qualification teaching experience. He/She should be familiar with the local primary curriculum and have substantial experience in English language teaching in local primary schools. Those with proven experience in teacher training in tertiary institutions or working with SEN students are highly preferred. Applicants who have less relevant post-qualification teaching experience will be considered for the post of Lecturer II.

Applicants should possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g., PGDE, or Qualified Teacher Status recognised by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other equivalent qualification.
