

Senior Research Assistant / Research Assistant I (Ref: 2400734) Department of Social Sciences and Policy Studies

The appointee will support a research project exploring the masculinities of young men in Hong Kong. He/she will work under the supervision of the Principal Investigator and primarily be responsible for conducting literature reviews, data analysis, drafting reports, drafting manuscripts, and performing other related tasks as assigned. The appointment will be for an initial period of around 4 months, with the possibility of extension subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a master's degree, preferably in sociology, anthropology, and social psychology plus one year's post master's degree full-time work experience or a doctorate degree. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a bachelor's degree preferably with relevant post-qualification full-time work experience. They should have knowledge of qualitative research methods and be familiar with gender studies and masculinities research. Proficiency in English is required, and understanding Chinese characters is an advantage.
