The appointee will participate in a school-based support project aimed to develop primary and secondary teachers' capacity to promote STEM/STEAM education in their schools. He/she will assist the Project Leaders and other members of the project in providing technical support for designing and implementing STEM/STEAM activities, collecting the necessary data/evidence for evaluation, analyzing data by undertaking statistical tests, and feeding the evaluation outcomes back to the Assistant Project Managers and school teachers for improvement. The appointment will be for a period of about 12 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably in Education / Science or related disciplines with at least one year of working experience, and good command of both written and spoken English. They should also have sound knowledge in research methodologies. Good IT competence and skills in design and technology are required. They should also be good team players, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure.
