The appointee will be responsible for providing research support to research program(s)/project(s); assisting in the application for potential overseas or local grants, writing up of research/project proposals conducting research activities including data collection, analysis, publication of findings in high-quality peer-reviewed journals, books and chapters, and reports; undertaking research project of research work in collaboration with the supervisor(s) and their research teams and research postgraduate students; and presenting findings in conferences, seminars, meetings, and knowledge transfer occasions; and performing any other research-related duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator and or his/her delegate(s). The appointment will be for 11 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Sport Science, Sport Management, Sport Psychology or a related fields. Experience in working with sports coaches and publication records in the same area are advantages. They should have sound experience with qualitative and/or quantitative methodologies, and knowledge in statistical analysis.

Applicants should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), as well as good communication skills and the ability to work independently under pressure.
