They should be highly motivated, responsible, adept at multi-tasking, and able to work independently under tight schedules. They should also have excellent analytical, decision-making, and interpersonal communication skills, high proficiency in both written and spoken Chinese (Cantonese) and English, strong PC skills (including MS Office and Photoshop), and experience with statistical tools (e.g., SPSS, R, or similar software).
