The University is now seeking applications for the post of Senior Lecturer II for its new strategic area(s) in E-Sports. The appointees will be responsible for teaching courses and provide support in the development of new programmes in E-Sports and related areas. Additionally, they are expected to contribute to curriculum and programme development, programme and course management, development/implementation of new projects, support student activities, provide student advising, and partake in departmental activities/meetings and various boards and committees, and provide good service contributions to the University and the community.

The appointees should have relevant teaching and professional/practical experience in the field of E-Sports or related fields.

For the post of Senior Lecturer II, applicants should have a Master's degree in a relevant subject discipline plus a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience in relevant areas; or preferably a Doctoral degree plus a minimum of 3 years' relevant post-qualification teaching / professional experience in the relevant subject discipline.

Possession of proficient knowledge and professional experiences of Esports business and marketing, Esports media production/ communication, Esports event/venue management, video game design/gaming studies is strongly preferred. It would be advantageous to applicants to have the ability to teach through English, Cantonese and Putonghua.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 15% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
