There will be chances for manuscript writing and publications. The initial appointment will be for an initial period of 6 months, with the possibility of renewal up to one year subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology or a related discipline. They should have high proficiency in both English and Chinese (including Cantonese), good communication skills, and organizational skills. Experience with social/educational psychology research, computer coding, and academic writing will be of advantage.
