Project Title: Music, Health and Wellbeing

We are seeking an appointee to support the project leader in conducting multiple projects on music, health, and wellbeing. The projects aim to study music interventions and music therapy programmes designed to alleviate stress and increase capacity for self-care among adolescents and young adults. The appointment will be for a period of around 2 months.

The appointee will take a proactive role in managing the project logistics, data collection, and research communication. In addition to research skills, the work requires the appointee to liaise with external organisations, study participants, music therapists, and others as needed.

Applicants should have a Doctoral Degree in Psychology or other disciplines related to Health, with relevant post-qualification full-time working experience. They should have excellent communication skills and have high proficiency in written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese). The applicant should have experience in collecting, analysing, and managing quantitative and qualitative data, and demonstrate a capacity for ethical decision-making and practice. Experience in music / other types of therapy research will be an advantage.
