The appointee will mainly be responsible for supporting the research projects by developing and maintaining web front-end components, processing and analyzing research data, and collaborating with team members to implement UI/UX design principles. Additional duties include drafting reports, supervising student helpers, managing administrative tasks, and performing other responsibilities as assigned by the project leader. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should hold a bachelor's degree (or be in their final year of study) in Computer Science, Educational Technology, Information Technology, or a related discipline. They should have experience in front-end programming with proficiency in HTML, CSS, and JavaScript, and familiarity with modern frameworks like React, Vue, or Angular. A solid understanding of UI/UX design principles is essential. Applicants should also have strong interpersonal and coordination skills, as well as a good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese or Mandarin). Preference will be given to candidates with experience in website development.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
