The Department of Science and Environmental Studies invites applications for the position of Teaching Assistant. We seek experienced and inspiring candidates to support our expanding learning and teaching initiatives. This role is ideal for individuals eager to contribute to dedicated teams and advance their careers in higher education. The initial appointment will be for a period of 2 years, with the possibility of renewal subject to performance and mutual agreement.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist in academic activities, including tutorials, laboratory sessions, in-class case discussions, field trips, practicums, and workshops, including those during off-office hours or on Saturdays.
- Provide technical support during lectures and assist in preparing course materials and administrative tasks.
- Participate in GBA/overseas experiential learning activities by planning, implementing, and supporting
 these activities, coordinating with partner organizations, and offering logistical and pastoral support to
 students.
- Support teaching and learning projects by assisting in developing and delivering course materials and resources and engaging in departmental academic project activities as assigned.
- Assist in assessing and marking students' assignments.
- Supervise students, provide pastoral support, invigilate exams, and grade assignments.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably with a Master's degree in Education or Science/Environmental-related disciplines. Candidates should have extensive experience in providing outreach or teaching support. Excellent command of both written English and Chinese, with proficiency in spoken English and Putonghua, is required. The ideal candidate will be self-motivated, well-organized, and possess strong interpersonal and communication skills. Working independently and collaboratively within a team is essential; candidates must perform effectively under pressure. Applicants with prior experience providing teaching support at tertiary institutions will be preferred.
