

**Educational Development Officer / Assistant Educational Development Officer**

The appointee will be responsible for supporting a collaborative project between the Centre for Learning, Teaching, and Technology (LTTC) and Library at the Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK), aimed at enhancing students' digital competency through innovative Virtual Reality (VR) educational games. The project leverages the Cave Automatic Virtual Environment (CAVE) platform to create immersive learning experiences.

The appointee will also need to design and develop VR educational games tailored to various academic subjects, ensuring engaging and interactive content. The successful candidate will provide technical and pedagogical support to academic and teaching staff in integrating Virtual Reality learning packages into their courses. Responsibilities include collecting and analyzing evaluation data to assess the effectiveness and impact of VR learning tools, as well as assisting in training staff and students to utilize the CAVE system for creating virtual journeys and interactive VR games. Additionally, he/she will perform administrative tasks related to the project, including promotion showcases, documentation, and coordination, as well as performing other duties assigned by the Centre Director and Executive Co-Director.

For the post of Educational Development Officer, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in a relevant field (e.g., education technology, game design, or creative media), with two or more years of post-qualification working experience. Proven experience in designing and developing AR/VR/Metaverse games or educational materials and proficiency in Unity, AI tools for creative arts (e.g., generative design software), and 360-degree video production are preferred. Applicants should also possess strong presentation and communication skills, with the ability to explain complex concepts clearly to diverse audiences. In addition, they should also have high proficiency in both English and Chinese (written and spoken) and hands-on experience with software such as Adobe Creative Cloud or similar multimedia production tools. A background in providing technical support or training, ideally to educators or students in STEM education, will be given higher priority.

Applicants with less experience will be considered for the post of Assistant Educational Development Officer.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits.
