Project Title: Development of New Capstone Project (CP) Pathway on Emerging Technologies (e.g. A.I.) in Teaching/ Work Contexts

[Appointment Period: around 15 months]

The appointee will provide implementation support for the project on the development of new Capstone Project (CP) pathway on emerging technologies (e.g., AI) in teaching/ work contexts. Duties include liaising with the three faculties for smooth project implementation, exploring emerging technologies and building prototypes for demonstration, developing evaluation instruments, organising training workshops and prototype sharing sessions. The appointee will also be responsible for developing and providing consultation services for students related to their final year projects on emerging technologies, including AI, LLM, application development, etc. as well as performing other duties assigned by the Centre Director.

Applicants are expected to have basic knowledge of data analytics, big data, and/or AI technologies, especially LLM. Knowledge of STEAM, metaverse, computer programming and using statistical packages such as SPSS and R will be advantageous. Preference will be given to those with work experience in tertiary institutions or the education sector. Applicants should be proficient in English and Chinese (Putonghua and Cantonese); able to handle multiple tasks simultaneously, and work proactively and independently. They should also have good problem solving, analytical and interpersonal skills and be a good team player.

Applicants for the Senior Research Assistant post should have a master's degree or an equivalent qualification in Computing, Information Technology or related disciplines with at least one year of post Master's degree full-time working experience. Software development and/or project management experience will be advantageous. Applicants with less relevant post-qualification working experience may be considered for the post of Research Assistant I.
