**Project Title: Investing in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) identities involving Generative AI: A longitudinal multiple case study of Hong Kong postgraduate EAP learners**

The appointee will work on the Seed Funding project “Investing in English for Academic Purposes (EAP) identities involving Generative AI: A longitudinal multiple case study of Hong Kong postgraduate EAP learners”, led by Dr. Yue Ellen ZHANG and funded by the Education University of Hong Kong.

The main duties include conducting literature review and interviews, editing, as well as collecting and analyzing data/related information. He/she will also assist in report/journal article writing, conference presentation preparation, teaching, and any other research-related tasks assigned by the supervisor. The appointment will initially be for a period of 10 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Bachelor's Degree and/or Master's degree in English Language or Linguistics. Applicants with IELTS 7 or equivalent will be an advantage. Candidates should possess some research experience, especially in the field of educational linguistics or EAP/ESP and also possess extensive experience in English language fieldwork, strong analytical and writing skills, an excellent command of written and spoken English, and good interpersonal skills. Preference will be given to applicants who have a doctoral degree or publications in the relevant field.
