Applicants should possess a recognized Bachelor's degree, and preferably a Master's degree, in Education, Psychology, or a related area, along with relevant research experience. Knowing how to use a variety of research tools would be favored, including but not limited to NVIVO, SPSS, and AMOS.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
