Project Title: The relationship between out-of-class L2 learning experiences and L2 learners' emotions, motivation, and self-efficacy among university students [Appointment Period: 8 months]

We are investigating second language (L2) learners' out-of-class learning experiences and the associated affective factors (e.g., emotions, motivation, and self-efficacy) and are searching for a Research Assistant I to assist with the literature review, participant recruitment, data collection, data analysis, and other related tasks. The appointee will provide support to the research team and perform academic duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. Research experience in research projects related to L2 acquisition, educational psychology, or informal digital learning of English is highly desirable. The appointment will be for a period of 8 months.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree (preferably a Master's degree) in Applied Linguistics, Education, Psychology, or a related discipline, with knowledge of quantitative and qualitative methods. He/she should have a high proficiency in both verbal and written English and Chinese, good communication and organizational skills, and a good ability to work both independently and collaboratively. Immediate availability is preferred.
