Project Title: Examining University Visual Arts Students' Perceptions of Human-Al Collaboration and Their Conception of Non-Human Creative Agencies: A Posthuman Perspective [Appointment Period: around 6 months]

If you are passionate about AI and the impact of AI on visual arts students' creativity, you may consider this chance for you.

The appointee is expected to skilfully analyse quantitative data using advanced tools such as Mplus and R. They will be responsible for reviewing the literature, collecting data, coding and analysing data, and drafting reports and manuscripts. The appointee will also coordinate activities facilitating the dissemination of research findings and perform other duties as assigned by the project leader. The initial appointment will be for a period of 6 months.

The applicant should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects, including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects, including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preferably with a master's degree in a psychology or education-related discipline, with a strong interest in arts. He/she should have research-related writing and publishing experience in English; be highly responsible, intrinsically motivated, and able to work independently; and have good interpersonal and organisational skills.
