We are seeking a Research Assistant II (full-time) to provide support for around 3 to 4 months for a research project relating to occupational choice in urban China. The appointee will be responsible for a range of research tasks including data cleaning, data analysis, literature review, and preparing conference presentations and research-related duties as assigned.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent, preferably with a Master's degree or above in the area of urban studies, public policy or a related field of social sciences; (ii) experience in quantitative research methods; (iii) Proficiency in written English. Preference will be given to those with research experience.
