Applications are invited for appointment as a Senior Research Assistant/Research Assistant I in the Department of English Language Education. The appointee(s) will provide support to the research team, and perform academic duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. Research experience in natural language processing (NLP) and machine learning is highly desirable. The initial appointment will be for a period of around 4 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's degree in computer science, computational linguistics or a related discipline, plus one year's post-Master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate in the abovementioned disciplines, with solid knowledge of machine learning and related working experiences would be an advantage. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree (preferably Master's degree) in related disciplines. They should also have good communication and organizational skills, high level of proficiency in spoken and written English and Chinese, good ability to work both independently and collaboratively. Immediate availability is preferred.
