We welcome applicants whose primary background is in linguistics, statistics, or computer science who are interested in the application of quantitative methods to humanities topics.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's degree, plus one year's post-Master's degree full-time working experience, or a doctorate in the abovementioned disciplines. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree in related disciplines. Candidates with an MPhil or PhD in a related area are preferred. If the candidate holds an MA/MSc, please submit a CV describing relevant working experience in detail. Candidates with previous experience conducting data analysis with Python or R is preferred.
