Description of the job advertisement. The appointee will participate in research projects focused on GenAI and LLM-based Agents for education innovation. He/she will be responsible for:

- studying the use of GenAI to enhance teaching & learning effectiveness, e.g., adaptive and personalised learning;
- designing and implementing AI agent prototypes to support context-aware task planning and content generation; and
- performing any other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator or his delegates.

There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publications in international journals or conferences.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSEE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to those with a Bachelor's Degree or above in Data Science, Computer Science, Information Technology, Artificial Intelligence, Educational Technology, or related disciplines with expertise in data science or artificial intelligence. Hands-on experience in programming and background knowledge in generative artificial intelligence will be an advantage. Applications should have good communication skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese, as well as good interpersonal and communication skills. They should be mature and able to work independently. Preference will be given to those with experience in research and/or project development.
