The appointee will be responsible for providing research support for an artificial intelligence (AI) education project. Duties include conducting literature review on AI education, developing and validating research instruments; conducting quantitative and qualitative data collection and analysis; writing academic papers and reports on AI education; reviewing the learning and teaching resources on AI education developed by the project team; as well as performing other duties assigned by the project principal investigator. The appointment will be for a period of 2 years.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree, preferably in Social Science, Psychology, Education, Computer Science, Information Technology, Language or related disciplines, plus one year's post-Master's Degree full-time working experience, or a Doctoral Degree.

Applicants should have an excellent command of written English and Chinese, a high capability of conducting statistical analysis, and writing reports/ papers independently. A sound background in statistics and experience in using statistical packages such as SPSS are expected. They should be self-motivated and able to work as a team member. Applicants who can speak fluent Cantonese and English would be preferred.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
