The appointee will assist in consolidating existing project outcomes into a series of polished deliverables for educational initiatives. The appointee will be responsible for supporting the project team. They will assist in and receive guidance on: (a) curating and refining project materials into cohesive multimedia outputs, (b) designing visual and digital content for diverse platforms, (c) documenting processes through photography/videography and editing, and (d) performing any other duties as assigned.

The appointment will be for 6 months, with the possibility of renewal upon mutual agreement. The start date is negotiable, ideally September 15, 2025, or as soon as possible thereafter.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree, preferably with a Master's degree in Art/Design, Media Studies, Communications, Digital Humanities, or a related field. Demonstrated experience in graphic design, photo/video editing, and multimedia production. Strong portfolio showcasing visual storytelling and technical proficiency (e.g., Adobe Creative Suite, Final Cut Pro). Excellent organizational skills and ability to synthesize complex information into accessible formats. Proficiency in written and spoken English and Chinese. Applicants should be self-motivated, responsible, organized, and able to work independently and in a team.
