Project Title: Lingnan Culture and the World: Construction and Change in the Cultural Landscape of Cantonese Literati from the late Qing to the Republican era in China (1821–1949)

[Appointment Period: around 7.5 months]

Starting from June 2023, the Education University of Hong Kong has joined a Collaborative Research Fund Project to motivate multidisciplinary approaches across local humanities fields to renew the studies of Lingnan culture. The project examines the construction and evolution of the Lingnan culture as seen in the lives and experiences of 150 key personalities among the Cantonese literati and merchant-gentry of the late Qing and Republican era (1821–1949)—an age of great change in the history of modern China.

The appointee will be required to collect, sort, and analyse information or research materials for the project, compile statistical data, and perform other duties as assigned. The appointees will be expected to commence employment around November 2025.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent.
