The appointees will provide support to research projects on an L2 Conversational Agent (LCA) for young learners in Hong Kong to promote English oral language competence. He/she will be responsible for preparing research materials, data collection and management, conducting data analysis and writing research papers and reports. He /She will handle administrative tasks and undertake other duties assigned by the Principal Investigator or his/her delegate(s).

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology and Education, preferably with experiences in supporting research and running intervention studies, and familiar with both quantitative and qualitative research methods. Applicants should also have a good command of written and spoken English and Chinese (Cantonese), be able to work independently and under pressure, and possess good interpersonal and organizational skills.
