The appointee will actively assist in research activities, including administering surveys and interviews across several regions in China, managing and analyzing both quantitative and qualitative data, and contributing to the production of research articles and conference presentations. Additional responsibilities may be assigned as required by the project supervisor. A well-established network with international students in Mainland Chinese universities will be considered a significant advantage.

Applicants should have obtained Master Degree and possess at least one year's post-qualification full-time experience in research project management, including strong interpersonal skills for effective stakeholder engagement. Prior working experience in higher education is highly desirable. The ideal candidate will demonstrate the ability to work independently as well as collaboratively within a research team. Excellent proficiency in both spoken and written English is essential for this position. Interested individuals are encouraged to submit a CV and cover letter outlining their relevant qualifications and experience.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
