We are seeking a motivated Research Assistant to support a policy research project focused on analyzing the talent needs for industrial chain integration between Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Area (GBA). The role will involve conducting literature reviews, collecting and analyzing qualitative and quantitative data, assisting in stakeholder engagement, and contributing to the preparation of research reports and policy recommendations. The ideal candidate will have a strong interest in regional development, public policy, and cross-border economic collaboration, along with the ability to work effectively in a dynamic academic environment.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience, or a Doctorate degree in Public Administration, Public Policy, Business Management, or a related field. Preferred qualifications include familiarity with the GBA policy landscape, demonstrated analytical and research skills, proficiency in both English and Mandarin, and experience in stakeholder communication or project management. Prior exposure to higher education, cross-sector collaboration, or strategic development within the GBA context will be highly advantageous.
