The department seeks research-oriented individuals to assist in the implementation and monitoring of research projects related to corpus linguistics, AI, and English education. The initial appointment will be for a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have strong collaborative abilities and hold a Master's Degree in Applied Linguistics, English, Education, Computer Science, or related disciplines, plus one year's post-Master's degree full-time working experience, or preferably a doctorate in the above mentioned disciplines. The candidates should have a good knowledge in corpus and/or AI technologies, as well as experience in academic research/writing in EAP or related fields.

For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should possess a Bachelor's degree (preferably Master's degree) in Applied Linguistics, English, Education, Computer Science, or related disciplines with over one-year post-qualification working experience are preferred. The candidates should have a solid understanding of English language teaching and learning, excellent command of English and Chinese, proficient computer skills, familiarity with popular AI tools, and preferably expertise in data collection and analysis (both quantitative and qualitative).
