Project Title: SUNRISE: An International Surveillance of Movement Behaviours in Kindergarten-aged Children

[Appointment Period: 12 months]

The appointee will be responsible for assisting in the implementation and monitoring of two research projects related to kindergarten-aged children and secondary school children and their teachers. S/he should be familiar with both qualitative and quantitative research data collection and analysis. Additionally, the appointee will be expected to write academic reports/papers, to conduct out of office data collection, and to take up some related administrative works when needed. The appointment will be expected a period of 12 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

For the post of Senior Research Assistant, applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience, preferably three years or more, in Physical Education, Sports Science or related fields. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education, Sports Science or related fields. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants should have a good command of both written and spoken English and Chinese (including Cantonese), as well as good communication skills and the ability to work independently under pressure.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include contract-end gratuity, leave, medical and dental benefits.
