The appointee will be working as a full-time Post-doctoral Fellow to support the academic project "Advancing a global academic hub for Chinese language teaching and learning: Development of *International Journal of Chinese Language Education (IJCLE)* in 2025-2028". The appointment will be for a period of 24 months. Renewal of contract is possible, subject to performance review.

The successful applicant will provide comprehensive academic and administrative support to the project. Responsibilities mainly include: (i) management of *IJCLE*'s editorial duties; (ii) research-related duties such as literature review, special issue planning, report/article writing, book editing, etc.; (iii) effective liaison between the journal's editorial board and external partners and collaborators; (iv) coordination of international conference organizing; and (v) any other duties assigned by the project PI and the Editors-in-Chief of *IJCLE*.

Applicants should have a PhD degree in a relevant discipline, such as Chinese language education, second/ foreign language acquisition, teaching Chinese as a second/ foreign language, applied linguistics, or other related fields. They should have a strong research background with a proven track record of publications, and experience in designing and conducting empirical studies related to the fields listed above. They should have an excellent command of both written and spoken English and Chinese. They should also be self-motivated, well-organized, have good interpersonal and communication skills, be able to work independently and collectively as a good team member and have the ability to work under pressure.
