The appointee will participate in a research project related to developing Artificial Intelligence (AI) algorithms for education applications. He or she will be responsible for designing and developing the AI system, gathering requirements and implementing solutions, training AI models, analyzing their performance, and performing any other duties as assigned. A strong interest in conducting research and academic manuscript writing will be an asset. There will be opportunities for manuscript writing and publication in international journals. The appointment will be for a period of 12 months.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preferably have a Bachelor's degree or above in Computer Science, Information Technology, and Artificial Intelligence, and demonstrate proficiency in AI technology and its applications. They should have strong programming skills, communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills in both written and spoken English and Chinese. They should also exhibit strong enthusiasm, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently and under pressure.
