The Office of the Chief Information Officer (<https://www.eduhk.hk/ocio>) provides essential IT services supporting the University's teaching, learning, research and administrative activities with a strong emphasis on staff development and professional growth. We are seeking an experienced and forward-thinking **IT Manager** to join our Finance & Human Resources Team.

### Key Responsibilities

The appointee will be responsible for:

- leading a team of technical staff, providing direction, coaching, workload planning, and performance management to ensure high-quality service delivery;
- user requirements gathering, system design, development, testing and documentation;
- vendor management; and
- maintenance of the central information systems, mainly finance, HR and student affairs related.

### Qualifications

The ideal candidate should have:

- A recognized Bachelor's Degree or above in Computer Science, Information Technology, or related disciplines, with preferably 8 years of relevant full-time post-qualification work experience gained in a sizeable IT environment;
- Proven team leadership experience, including mentoring staff, coordinating work assignments, and ensuring effective team performance;
- Solid experience and knowledge in web application development with backend technology (including Java/J2EE, Spring Boot running on JBOSS EAP, SQL, PL/SQL), frontend technology (including VueJS, ReactJS, jQuery, Ajax, HTML5) and responsive UI tools and JavaScript library (including Google Material Design, Bootstrap);
- Solid experience and knowledge in application development including hands-on experience with application servers (such as TOMCAT and JBOSS), continuous integration and deployment (CI/CD) practices, and tools like Jenkins. Experience in Docker will be an advantage;
- Experience in using AI and/or agentic AI for process automation would be a strong plus;
- Prior experience in Oracle RDBMS & ERP applications (finance & HRMS) will be an advantage;
- Proficiency in English and Chinese;
- Ability to handle multiple tasks simultaneously, and work proactively and independently; and
- Good problem-solving, analytical and interpersonal skills, and be a good team player.

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Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Initial appointment will be made on a fixed-term contract. Fringe benefits include the University's Voluntary Contributions to MPF Scheme or a contract-end lump sum payment (totaling up to 10% of the basic salary), leave, medical and dental benefits. The appointee will hold a substantive rank of Computer Officer in the University.
