Project Title: Math and Language Learning Project
[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will work on a neuroscience-based project investigating mathematics and language learning. He/She will assist the Principal Investigator in designing experimental tasks, conducting literature reviews, collecting data, and performing advanced statistical analysis. He/She will also carry out other duties as assigned by the Principal Investigator. The appointment will be for a period of around 6 months, with the possibility of renewal subject to funding availability and satisfactory performance.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants who possess a recognized Bachelor's degree, and preferably a Master's degree or higher in STEM Education, Educational Technology, Educational Psychology, Computer Sciences, or related fields would be an advantage.

Applicants must have a strong background in quantitative data processing and analysis (e.g., R, MATLAB, Python), demonstrated experience in conducting independent literature reviews, and a proven record of publications in SSCI/SCI journals. Excellent written and spoken English is required, and proficiency in Chinese is preferred. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, along with the ability to work both independently and collaboratively, are essential. Preference will be given to applicants with prior STEM teaching experience, willingness to learn EEG experimental techniques, and fluency in Cantonese.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
