Project Title: Family Navigation of AI in Children's Learning: A Pilot Study in Hong Kong

The Education University of Hong Kong invites applications for the position of Part-time Research Assistant I. The appointee will play a key role in a qualitative research project exploring the perspectives and experiences of families concerning the use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools in children's learning. The appointee will be responsible for:

1. Assisting in all stages of the research project, with a primary focus on primary data collection;
2. Assisting in the recruitment of participant families and the execution of in-depth, semi-structured interviews with parents and children;
3. Assisting with ethnographic home observations, including note-taking and logistical coordination;
4. Assisting with data transcription, coding, analysis, and literature reviews; and
5. Performing any other duties as assigned.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Education, Social Sciences, Sociology, or a related discipline. They should have high proficiency in both English and Cantonese. They should have a strong sense of responsibility, the ability to work independently, and to work flexible hours as required by the research schedule. Previous experience with qualitative research methods (e.g., interviews, observations) would be preferred but not required. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview.
