The appointee is responsible for providing research and administrative support to the UNESCO Chair programme, delivering Central Asia-oriented courses, and supporting curriculum and instruction-related courses and research. His/her duties include conducting literature reviews, data collection, and data analysis, as well as drafting research reports and manuscripts for publication in international journals. The candidate will also provide administrative support, maintain databases, and perform any other duties as assigned by supervising officers.

Applicants should possess a Doctoral degree in Higher Education, Education Studies, Education Leadership, or related disciplines. They should demonstrate familiarity with the Belt and Road Initiative and its associated countries, along with relevant teaching experience. Strong interpersonal and communication skills, proficiency in both English and Chinese, and advanced computer application skills are required. Attention to detail, self-motivation, and the ability to work independently or as part of a committed team are critical for success in this role.
