**Project Title: Asia Pacific Teacher Entrepreneurialism Research

The appointee will join a large-scale research project focusing on entrepreneurial leadership, teacher entrepreneurialism, school networking, and capacity building across the Asia Pacific region. The project examines the impact of entrepreneurship education, cross-school and cross-sector collaboration, and leadership development in higher education and senior secondary school contexts.

Responsibilities will include conducting literature reviews, designing and administering research instruments, and performing quantitative and qualitative data analysis (e.g. multilevel or social network analysis where appropriate). The appointee will also draft research reports and academic outputs, assist in coordinating fieldwork and project activities, and provide essential administrative and research support to the project team.

Applicants should have a Master's Degree plus one year's post Master's degree full-time working experience or a PhD degree.

Preference will be given to applicants with good knowledge of how to run multilevel (ML) analysis by Mplus. Or Social Network analysis and the ability to work independently with minimal direct supervision. They should also be good team players, attentive to details, highly self-motivated, and able to work under pressure. Immediate availability is preferred.
