Project Title: Occurrence and Ecological Risks of Lithium Battery-Related Emerging PFAS in Waters Surrounding Hong Kong

Department of Science and Environmental Studies, the Education University of Hong Kong, will be recruiting a Research Assistant to support research in environmental analytical chemistry. The project focuses on the analysis of pollutants in environmental samples and will involve routine sample preparation and pretreatment, instrument operation, and data processing using GC–MS and LC–MS. The appointee will also assist with laboratory organisation, documentation, and any other duties as assigned. The appointment is expected to commence around April 2026, with the possibility of renewal subject to mutual agreement.

Applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Preference will be given to candidates holding a Master’s degree in Environmental Science, Analytical Chemistry, or a related discipline, or a Bachelor’s degree with at least one year of relevant working experience. Applicants should be familiar with common sample preparation techniques and have hands-on experience with GC–MS and/or LC–MS. Good written and spoken English communication skills are required.
