The appointee will participate in teaching, knowledge transfer and community service. The applicant will also develop, evaluate and teach in programmes at both undergraduate and postgraduate levels, including professional development programmes to in-service teachers; provide guidance to students in the capacity of academic adviser; supervise students on teaching practice, and contribute to departmental and faculty activities.

Applicants should have a Doctoral degree (EdD or PhD), preferably in English language teaching and learning, applied linguistics, sociolinguistics (with a focus on education), or a related field, with substantial post-qualification teaching experience in a tertiary education setting.

Applicants should preferably have experience of teacher training and/or possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong, or equivalent qualifications. Experience in one or more of the following areas will be an advantage: front-line teaching experience at the primary or secondary level; experience working with local minoritized students; GBA experience; demonstrated competence in digital pedagogy, e-learning, and AI-enhanced teaching and learning.
