The Academy for Educational Development and Innovation (AEDI) is seeking inspirational and energetic candidates to join the University in support of its development in the areas of **E-Commerce, Business Management, Communication and New Media**.

The appointee will be responsible for teaching, designing, reviewing, and updating course materials, learning activities, and assessment tasks aligned with programme learning outcomes, as well as supporting curriculum development and implementation, including integration of innovative pedagogies and educational technologies where appropriate. In addition, the appointee will provide academic and/or professional guidance to learners (e.g., consultation hours, feedback on assessments, and mentoring), contribute to quality assurance processes (e.g., course evaluation, moderation, documentation, and continuous improvement), and collaborate with AEDI colleagues and stakeholders on teaching-related initiatives and other duties as assigned.

Applicants should have a relevant Master's degree in the related discipline(s) and a minimum of 8 years' relevant post-qualification work experience, with demonstrated subject expertise and competence. Alternatively, applicants should have a Doctoral degree and at least 3 years of relevant post-qualification work experience. Candidates with less experience will be considered for Professional Consultant.

All candidates should have relevant professional experience in the related discipline(s) and a good network with the professional organisations of the disciplines and/or higher education institutions in Hong Kong and Chinese Mainland. Applicants should also have excellent interpersonal, language (written and verbal), management, and presentation skills, be highly self-motivated, and be able to formulate and implement plans independently while working under pressure. They should have demonstrably strong leadership skills to manage projects and to liaise with the education community, university scholars, and multi-sector stakeholders.
