We welcome applications from qualified candidates with relevant experience and a strong commitment to teaching and scholarship in these fields.

In addition to course teaching, the appointee will participate in activities related to project supervision, field experience supervision, internship supervision, guidance to students in the capacity of personal tutors, and so on. The appointee is expected to contribute to curriculum and programme development, programme and course management and partake in departmental activities and represent the Department in meetings and various boards and committees, and provide good service contributions to the University and the community. The appointees should have some relevant teaching experience in local school curriculum development, pedagogical studies, AI-enabled teaching innovations, assessment, and/or heritage and cultural studies, as well as demonstrating leadership and the ability to work collaboratively with colleagues and external partners.

Applicants should have a Doctoral degree, with at least four years' post-master's degree qualification teaching experience in the applied subject area. We look forward to receiving applications from motivated candidates who can contribute to excellence in teaching, research-informed practice, and community engagement. Applicants should preferably possess a relevant professional teaching certificate, e.g. PGDE or qualification of Qualified Teacher Status recognized by the Education Bureau of Hong Kong or other qualification of equivalence, and provide proven evidence of quality teaching and/or successful record of relevant professional experience, at primary/secondary and or tertiary level. It would be advantageous to applicants to have the ability to teach through more than one medium of instruction (English/ Cantonese/ Putonghua).
