Applicants should possess a doctoral degree in Artificial Intelligence, Data Science, Computer Science, Information Technology, Educational Technology or a closely related discipline, plus post-qualification teaching experience in tertiary education setting, preferably possessing qualified teacher status and/or professional qualifications in the relevant subject areas. They should have some knowledge of the educational context of Hong Kong and/or the Chinese Mainland. Preference will be given to those who have created AI innovations to advance teaching and learning activities or with professional experience in industrial, commercial, or public sectors with a proven track record of project work.
