The appointee will lead a project promoting innovative pedagogies for subject learning, self-regulated learning, and computational thinking development. He/she will be responsible for leading the design of teaching and learning materials for subject-specific teaching trials, project evaluation, and the planning of research activities, including pre-and post-tests, questionnaire surveys, and focus group interviews. The appointee will analyze research data, write project reports, and organize annual dissemination activities. He/she will also be expected to carry out other duties as assigned by the Centre Director. The appointment will be until 31 August 2026.

Applicants should have a Bachelor's degree, preferably a Master's degree in Social Sciences or related discipline, with 12 years or more of working experience in sizable organizations, strong leadership and supervisory skills, and excellent interpersonal and communication abilities. They should be well-versed in the local education environment, particularly in the primary school sector, and capable of identifying key strategic issues in primary school education. Applicants should also have excellent written and verbal communication skills, with high proficiency in written English and Chinese, as well as spoken English and Cantonese.

Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Fringe benefits include leave and outpatient medical benefits.
