Project Title: Using brain stimulation to reduce loneliness and depression
[Appointment Period: 6 months]

The appointee will work on projects related to loneliness, depression, and brain health. They will support the research team in planning and conducting the project activities. The appointee will conduct literature review and prepare assessment materials. They will help with the collection of behavioural, neuroimaging (e.g. MRI), neurophysiological (e.g. EEG) and brain stimulation data (e.g. tDCS), data management and data analysis. The appointee will also assist in manuscript writing and any other duties as assigned. They may have to travel to other institutions. The initial appointment will be for a period of 6 months.

Applicants should have a good command of Cantonese as well as a good command of written Chinese and English. For the post of Research Assistant I, applicants should have a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology, Cognitive neuroscience, or a related discipline, with some research experience. For the post of Research Assistant II, applicants should have at least Level 2 or equivalent or above in five subjects including Chinese Language, English Language and Mathematics in HKDSE; or Grade E (Level 2) or above in five subjects including Chinese, English (Syllabus B) and Mathematics in HKCEE or equivalent. Applicants should also have good interpersonal skills and organisational skills. Having research experience in cognitive neuroscience and psychology, especially in their research methods and analysis, will be a definite advantage.
